All sessions are planned according to the project training objectives and will be delivered through non-formal learning methods, including workshops, interactive seminars, group work, debates and reflection activities.

Minor practical adjustments may be made on site in line with group needs and travel logistics.

## Arrival and Reception - Sunday, 19 April 2026

Time	Activity
From 13:00	Participant arrivals and reception at the venue.
13:00-20:00	Blue Beehive team on site to welcome delegations, support check-in and practical coordination.

On arrival, the Blue Beehive coordination team will discuss the practical details of the agenda with each national team as they arrive. **The first official training session starts on Monday, 20 April 2026 at 9:30 in the main hall.**

## Day 1 - Monday, 20 April 2026

*Welcome, group integration and foundations of AI in youth work*

Time	Programme
9:30-10:30	Official opening in the main hall. Welcome by the hosting team, presentation of the training framework and practical orientation.
10:30-12:00	Session 1 - Welcome and intercultural integration. Introduction round, team-building and first group connections among partner organisations.
12:00-13:30	Session 2 - Introduction to Artificial Intelligence and digital literacy. Interactive seminar on what AI is, how it works and why it matters in youth work and in young people's lives.
16:00-17:15	Ice-breaking activity 1 - Traditional Food Exchange. Each participant brings a traditional food or sweet from their country, introduces themselves and shares a short story around that product (real or invented).
17:15-18:00	Session 3 - Introduction to Youthpass. Presentation of the Youthpass framework and the learning approach for the week.
18:00-19:00	Daily reflection. Expectations mapping, first learning notes and group debrief.

**Note:** Coffee breaks, lunch arrangements and small logistical adjustments may be coordinated daily by the facilitation team according to venue operations and group needs.

*Ethics, digital citizenship and critical thinking*

10:00-11:30	Session 1 - Ethics, safety and privacy in AI. Workshop on ethical implications, online safety, personal data protection and responsible use of digital tools with young people.
11:45-13:30	Session 2 - Digital citizenship and fighting misinformation. Practical activities on media literacy, source checking and critical thinking.
16:00-17:15	Ice-breaking activity 2 - Team Clue Hunt. Group challenge based on clues and problem-solving tasks to strengthen communication, cooperation and trust.
17:15-18:15	Debrief of the clue hunt. Reflection on teamwork, decision-making and how playful methods can support

<b>18:15-19:00</b>	Daily reflection. Review of ethical challenges discussed during the day and the role of youth workers as promoters of safe and critical technology use.

## Day 3 - Wednesday, 22 April 2026

*Personal Learning Environment (PLE) development - Part I*

<b>10:00-11:30</b>	Session 1 - Introduction to the PLE methodology and Symbaloo. Presentation of the previous PLE4YOUTH approach and the structure of the collaborative learning environment.
<b>11:45-13:30</b>	Session 2 - Exploration of AI tools in 4 working groups. Guided analysis of digital applications relevant to the youth sector.
<b>16:00-17:30</b>	Session 3 - Drafting application fiches. Collaborative work on tool descriptions, recommendations for use and ethical considerations.
<b>17:30-19:00</b>	Session 4 - Daily reflection and peer review. Group feedback on the selection process and initial outcomes.

## Day 4 - Thursday, 23 April 2026

*Personal Learning Environment (PLE) development - Part II*

<b>10:00-11:30</b>	Session 1 - Consolidation of the collaborative PLE in Symbaloo. Structuring and refining the selected digital resources.
<b>11:45-13:30</b>	Session 2 - Design of non-formal educational activities. Workshop on integrating the selected tools into practical youth work programmes.
<b>16:00-17:30</b>	Group design lab. Adaptation of activities to the needs, interests and extracurricular contexts of young people.
<b>17:30-19:00</b>	Daily reflection. Peer feedback on the proposed activities and discussion of practical implementation issues.

## Day 5 - Friday, 24 April 2026

*Impact evaluation and personal action plans*

10:00-11:30	Session 1 - Evaluation of digital interventions. Training on metrics, feedback collection and critical assessment of activities implemented with young people.
11:45-13:30	Session 2 - Development of personal action plans. Each participant prepares a plan for applying the acquired competences, tools and PLE methodology in their own context.
16:00-17:30	Session 3 - Mentoring and exchange of action plans. Presentation of plans, peer support and facilitator guidance.
17:30-19:00	Daily reflection. Individual learning journal, refinement of action points and preparation for follow-up.

*Dissemination, recognition and closure*

10:00-11:30	Session 1 - Dissemination strategies. Planning how to share the PLE and project results with colleagues, organisations and local communities.
11:45-13:00	Session 2 - Final evaluation of the mobility. Completion of final assessment tools and collective review of outcomes.
16:00-17:15	Session 3 - Youthpass finalisation and recognition of learning outcomes.
17:15-18:30	Closing session and certificate ceremony. Final remarks, acknowledgements and celebration of the mobility results.
